



Publishing Your Article in a Fully Open Access Journal

Open Access Payments Made Easy with Your Institution or Funder

Step 1

Visit www.wileyopenaccess.com/viewjournals and choose from one of Wiley's fully open access journals

Step 2

During submission, select your institution from the **Funder/Institution** drop-down menu

Step 3

Your institution is notified of your request and asked to approve

Step 4

If your request is approved, you will receive a confirmation email. Your accepted article is then published **open access** under a Creative Commons license on Wiley Online Library

Step 4

If your request is denied, you will receive an email asking you to pay for your APC. Paid articles are then published **open access** under a Creative Commons license on Wiley Online Library
