Open access payments made easy with your institution or funder



Step 1

Once your article is accepted, register or log-in to Wiley Author Services at www.wileyauthors.com*

On your Author Dashboard in Author Services, click **'Select OnlineOpen.'**

Step 2

CONFIRM YOUR AFFILIATION(S)

You may be asked to enter your affiliation(s) from the drop down list or confirm the affiliation(s) you entered during submission. You may also tick **'I have no affiliations.'**

Your OnlineOpen charges may be waived based your institution affiliations. In order to determine eligibility, we need to identify institution uniquely. We are using the Ringgold database for institutional information. Please ensure that all your institutions have been validated against the provided list.

If your request is denied, you will receive an email asking you to pay for **open access**.† Paid articles are then published open access under a Creative Commons license on Wiley Online Library

* Be sure to register for Author Services with the same email address used when submitting your article

† If you are unwilling or unable to pay for open access, your article will be published on Wiley Online Library as a subscription article
